**Senior Resource Association's 1st Annual Pro-Am Golf and Golf Croquet Tournament aims to help alleviate senior hunger in Indian River County  
90 golfers and PGA pros tee off February 15th at the newly renovated Riomar Country Club**

*Vero Beach, FL – February 5, 2016* - More than 90 golfers, PGA pros and golf croquet players will tee off for Senior Resource Association (SRA) at 12:30pm on Monday, February 15th at Riomar Country Club. The 1st Annual Pro-Am Golf and Golf Croquet Tournament will raise awareness and much-needed funds for SRA's Meals on Wheels program. The goal is simple but critical: help alleviate hunger and improve food insecurity for thousands of aging adults in Indian River County.

A cocktail dinner gala and live auction will immediately follow the tournament at Riomar Country Club. A paddle-raise will also give participants a unique opportunity to "Adopt a Senior" for a month, a quarter or the entire year. Proceeds will provide hot, nutritious meals for homebound seniors. The cost to deliver a daily meal to one senior for one year is \$2,200. In many instances, an older adult might be able to afford to buy food, but they are no longer able to prepare meals or drive themselves to the grocery store. The Meals on Wheels delivery by a Senior Resource Association volunteer provides nourishment, socialization and a daily wellness check.

Karen Deigl, SRA President and CEO said, "The waiting list of seniors in our community needing a daily hot meal continues to grow. The demand for our services exceeds our funding. We're extremely grateful to all who have stepped up to participate in the tournament and help us provide a lifeline to so many deserving older adults."
